

WESCLIN COVID-19 Return to School Flowchart

1. Student/Staff has symptoms of COVID-19 (whether they were tested or not)

Student/Staff may return to school after:

- At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared; AND
- At least 24 hours with no fever without fever-reducing medication; AND
- Symptoms have improvements.
- Dr. note with specific diagnosis of condition causing symptoms, other than COVID 19
- If the case is severe, the student should consult with their physician to determine when it is safe to return.

2. Student/Staff tested positive for COVID-19, but has no symptoms

Student/Staff may return to school after:

- At least 10 days have passed since the date of first COVID-19 positive test.
- If symptoms develop, follow scenario number 1 above.

3. Student/Staff had close contact with someone with COVID-19/Symptoms

Close contact: 1) Being within 6 feet of someone, for at least 15 minutes AND 2) contact occurred within 48 hours before person felt sick OR 3) Household Contact

Student/Staff may return to school after:

- At least 14 days have passed since last contact with the infected individual.
- If symptoms develop, follow scenario number 1 above.

4. Student/Staff returned from international travel

Student/Staff may return to school after:

- At least 14 days have passed since date of return from trip.
- If symptoms develop, follow scenario No 1. above.

Note: Wesclin School District is required to notify Clinton County Health Department with the name of any student/staff with a confirmed COVID-19 test or who is presenting with symptoms of COVID-19. We will also assist in contact tracing.
