Crossroads Community Hospital Auxiliary will present **four** (4) **\$1,000** scholarships to those who meet the following criteria:

Auxiliary Scholarships are for <u>tuition only</u>, any unused scholarship funds should be refunded to Crossroads Auxiliary.

ELIGIBILTY FOR 2024 SCHOLARSHIP

- 1) Applicant must be:
 - a. Pursuing a medical related profession.
 - b. Currently enrolled in a hospital related healthcare profession curriculum.
 - c. High School Senior who resides in Jefferson County or Student at Rend Lake College.
 - d. Maintaining grade point average of 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale.

1. FACTS PERTAINING TO SCHOLARSHIP

- 1) CCHA Scholarships will be given on an academic year (4 quarters or 2 semester).
- 2) All Jefferson County High Schools will be notified of available CCHA Scholarship funds. The Auxiliary President and Volunteer Services Coordinator will provide applications to Jefferson County High Schools. Dates for return and announcements will be noted on the yearly.

Current return date is April 1, 2024.

- 3) Application must be accompanied by a cover letter addressed to the "Scholarship Auxiliary Chair" by the determined date on the application.
- 4) Applicant must submit the following a part of the application.
 - a. An official high school transcript of grades:
 - b. A personal profile, stressing the factor relevant to occupational choice and goals.
 - c. Qualifications applicant feels he/she has in order to pursue the chosen profession.
- 5) Four (4) letters of reference from community member, teachers, counselors, coaches, supervisors for clergy. References from relatives are not acceptable.
- 6) CCHA Scholarship Selection Committee will award scholarships based on Scholarship Evaluation form which is to be included with the Application.
- 7) All returned applications are to be given directly to the Volunteer Services Coordinator who will redact all student names, picture or any means of identification on application, cover letters and reference letters to provide unbiased determinations.
- 8) The Scholarship Committee will consist of a minimum of three (3) Auxiliary members appointed by the Auxiliary President. If additional members are appointed to this committee, here must be a consistent odd number.
- 10) Scholarship recipients will be determined by the Scholarship Committee according to the criteria on the Scholarship Evaluation form.

- 11) Volunteer Services Coordinator will arrange the Award Ceremony date/time, contact scholarship recipients' and advise the date/time of Award Ceremony, contact newspaper for photo opportunity refreshments and Scholarship Certificate(s). Volunteer Services Coordinator will also contact previous years' recipients to attend Award Ceremony and present their experiences as a college student and how this Scholarship helped them achieve their first year goals.
- 12) Scholarship recipient will be provided the Scholarship Packet identifying the specific information required to process a check request and that this process may take approximately 60 days.
- 13) Volunteer Services Coordinator will provide the scholarship recipients information upon receiving the required documents from the student(s) along with the "Supporting Information" form, and forward to the Scholarship Chairperson.
- 14) Scholarship Chairperson will:
 - a. complete the required check voucher with scholarship recipients' information on the "Supporting Information" form,
 - b. obtain the Auxiliary President's (or designated board representative) signature and
 - c. forward directly to the Treasurer.
- 15) Once the authorized check voucher is received from the Chairperson, the Treasurer will process the scholarship check and return check and forms to the Volunteer Services Coordinator.
- 16) The Volunteer Services Coordinator will include a standard form letter to the college/university along with the check. A copy of the same letter will be sent to the student for reference/confirmation. A copy of these documents will also be maintained for reference.
- 17) Those who are not selected will be notified by letter, signed from the Auxiliary President, and Scholarship Chairperson. Volunteer Services Coordinator will prepare and mail once signed.

Scholarship Evaluation Form

Four (4) Corssroads Community Hospital Auxiliary Scholarships of \$1,000.00 will be awarded to deserving High School students / Rend Lake College students in Jefferson County, IL annually. Applicants will be evaluated on the following criteria by a committee of an odd number of Auxiliary members. Four (4) students with the highest total accumulated score will become the recipients and awarded their certificates at the award ceremony. The Auxiliary President and Auxiliary members will present the certificate. Points are awarded by placement on a 1-5 scale, then determined by totaling the accumulated scores. 1 being the lowest and 5 the highest. Applications and supporting required documents will have student personal blocked out and will be replaced with a number based on the number of applications received by the date specified.
