- Identify draft recommendations for priority pedestrian and bicycle corridors.
- Review possible types of improvements to priority corridors and intersections.
- Seek public input from the Monona community.

Did you know:

- From 2011-15 in Dane County there were 798 documented motor vehicle crashes involving bicyclists and 552 crashes involving pedestrians.
- From 2011-15 in Monona, the frequency of bicycle and pedestrian crashes per frequent commuter based on 2010 census data was 2 to 3 times that of the City of Madison and Dane County
- 43% of people with safe places to walk meet recommended activity levels, compared to 27% without them.
