

SCRIP Update – February 2020 Tuition Credits

Dear IHM Families,

The IHM Scrip program remains an outstanding way to raise money for the Home & School Association while simultaneously helping you ***reduce your own tuition costs!***

If you aren't already using the program, please consider getting started. SCRIP is simply gift cards that you purchase at face value. Cards are available for local gas and grocery stores as well as from hundreds of national retailers. IHM receives a discount from buying the cards through Great Lakes Center's ShopWithScrip.com. That discount is then split between you and IHM; **50% goes toward your tuition and 50% goes to the IHM Home and School Association.**

A rebate statement will be attached to this letter if you earned a tuition credit for purchases between January 1 and June 30, 2019. The rebate on the statement will be reflected on your FACTS Tuition bill for the month of February.

Thank you for the support of this program! It is beneficial to families in reducing tuition as well as supporting the great programs that HSA funds at IHM.

The new rebate session began Jan 1st and will continue until June 30, 2020. Rebates accumulated during this time frame will be credited to FACTS on the September 2020 bill.

It can take time to develop the habit of using SCRIP, but it can be very beneficial so please consider paying for your everyday purchases as well as gifts and travel with SCRIP. You do not incur any additional cost over and above the face value of the cards you purchase, and the profit helps make IHM the great school that it is!
